Dr. Giulia Friso obtained her B.Sc. and M.Sc. in Biology & Biochemistry and her Ph.D. in Biochemistry and Biophysics at the University of Padua (Italy). She was a graduate student and a postdoctoral fellow at the Department of Biochemistry at Imperial College, London (U.K.), and at the Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry at U.C.S.F. in San Francisco. She was also a research scientist at the pharmaceutical company AstraZeneca's discovery unit in Stockholm (Sweden). Giulia joined the Plant Biology Department at Cornell University in 2001.

Giulia Friso's research and teaching activities focus on the complexity of plant chemical compounds, exploring their potential for solutions to health, dietary and sustainability issues. In her classroom, online and eCornell courses, she makes the connections between food and health, introduces past and current plant-based natural remedies used around the globe, and explores their relationship with indigenous people, their traditional medicine systems, and their efficacy and modes of action.

By exploring plants pharmacological properties and toxicities, and comparing how plants consumed as food, herbal extracts, dietary supplements, and western medicines are used and regulated, her students not only acquire a deeper appreciation and respect for the natural world, but also a better understanding of the potential benefit and risk of plant-based medicine.

- ◆ Sample the rich flavors of Marsala with a guided tasting of this famed Sicilian wine.
- ◆ Experience the scenic countryside and historic treasures of Lipari, one of the seven Aeolian Islands.
- ◆ Delight in a private reception with a nobleman who welcomes guests to his Baroque palazzo, dating back to the Middle Ages.



Itinerary

Monday–Tuesday, May 24–25

DEPART HOME/ VALLETTA, MALTA

Overnight flight to Valletta, a city known for its Baroque architecture, historic fortifications, and charming cafés that reflect its rich heritage. Upon arrival, transfer to *Sea Cloud II* and meet fellow travelers at a welcome orientation and reception.

Wednesday, May 26

VALLETTA

Start the day with two full-day excursions to choose from. Explore Malta's prehistoric and archaeological treasures with visits to the National Archaeological Museum, Tarxien Temples, and the Hypogeum, an underground site renowned for its prehistoric significance. Alternatively, tour Valletta's architecture, including the ornate interiors

of St John's Cathedral and modern works by Renzo Piano. Depart in the evening, sailing from the historic harbor toward Sicily. *Sea Cloud II (B,L,D)*

Thursday, May 27

AT SEA

Enjoy a full day under sail. As part of the educational program, attend a lecture, take a guided tour of the ship, or, weather permitting, use the tenders to photograph *Sea Cloud II*. In the evening, the Captain's welcome reception and dinner provide the perfect opportunity to mingle with your fellow travelers.

Friday, May 28

TRAPANI

Begin the day exploring the Greek Doric temple of Segesta, perched on Mount Barbaro with panoramic views over Sicily's countryside. Later,

choose between two afternoon excursions, one being a visit to the medieval hilltop town of Erice, known for its cobbled streets and Norman castle, or sample the fortified wines of Marsala with a guided tasting. *Sea Cloud II (B,L,D)*

Saturday, May 29

PALERMO

Spend the morning visiting Palermo's Norman castle, Capella Palatina with its stunning mosaics, and Monreale Cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Enjoy lunch in Palermo's Old Town, followed by two afternoon options: the Abatellis Art Museum, which houses Sicilian and Renaissance masterpieces, or the Archaeological Museum, featuring an impressive collection of ancient artifacts. *Sea Cloud II (B,L,D)*

Sunday, May 30
LIPARI, AEOLIAN ISLANDS

Discover Lipari with a walking tour that includes the Archaeological Museum, or take a scenic drive with free time to wander the town's charming streets and coastline. In the afternoon, enjoy swimming, sailing, and educational programming, followed by a sunset cruise past Stromboli to see its volcanic activity.

Monday, May 31
GIARDINI NAXOS

Embark on one of two morning excursions to Mount Etna, visiting Silvestri Crater and riding the cable car to the summit, or head to Taormina to tour the 3rd-century B.C.

Greco-Roman amphitheater and enjoy free time in town. The afternoon is dedicated to relaxation on deck while taking in Sicily's coastline.

Tuesday, June 1
SYRACUSE

Tour Syracuse Archaeological Park, then stroll through Ortygia Island, experiencing the morning market and Cathedral Square. In a private Baroque palazzo, enjoy a wine tasting hosted by a nobleman. The afternoon is spent cruising to Malta, concluding with the Captain's farewell reception and dinner.





WHAT TO EXPECT

This is a moderately strenuous program, at times physically demanding and busy, with considerable walking at some sites. Daily activities can involve up to two miles of walking, often on uneven surfaces; elevators may not be available and stairs may not have handrails. The ship does not have an elevator, so you will need to navigate stairs, possibly while on choppy seas. You will need to climb into and out of tenders for two shore excursions (staff and crew will be on hand to assist). Participants should be fit and in active good health. Limited medical facilities are available on board the *Sea Cloud II*.

GROUP SIZE

This program can accommodate 78 participants, including travelers from Cornell's Adult University, National Trust Tours, Harvard Alumni Travels and the Archaeological Institute of America.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Travel insurance for trip cancellation and interruption, medical problems, baggage loss and delay, etc., is highly recommended. Trip cancellation policies that apply to this expedition are included in this brochure. Information about travel insurance will be sent to confirmed participants.

A NOTE ABOUT RATES

Tour rates are based upon current fuel prices, currency values, taxes, tariffs, and a minimum number of participants. While we will do everything possible to maintain the listed rates, they are subject to change. If there are significant changes, details and costs will be advised prior to departure.
