Package FAQs

What does the registration fee include?

All packages include class meals, headquarters refreshments, campus transportation, most university events including Arts Quad Tent Parties, and the cost of hiring and housing Cornell student clerks.

What is NOT automatically included?

CU for Lunch, some athletic events, concerts, and the additional opt-in selections listed here.

What are registration fees for children or caregivers?

Registration fees for children are lower. Children 5 and under attend for FREE. Special pricing is available for the Bring Your Own Babysitter registration package and 2011 will help offset the cost for families enrolling in the Cornell Childcare Center services on Saturday. If you wish to bring a caregiver to reunion or enroll in Cornell CCC, please reach out to us at cornellclassof2011@gmail.com.

Can I celebrate with more than one class or group?

Yes! Register with the class, school, or group with whom you wish to be housed and will participate most with. Contact cornellclassof2011@gmail.com to share which events hosted by another class or group you'd like to add to your registration.

What if I register and then can't come?

We are happy to offer refunds if you cancel on or before May 22. After this date, a refund of registration packages fees may not be possible.

Can I register when I get there?

Yes, you can—but there are many advantages to registering in advance, including lower fees (by May 15), expedited check-in, better chance of getting a room assignment near friends, and more. **Please note:** Cash payments will not be accepted. Check and credit/debit card payments are the only acceptable payment methods for Reunion purchases.

Housing FAQs

What's included in the room fee?

The university provides bath towels, wash cloths, soap, hangers, bed linens, a pillow, water glass, and daily towel and wash cloth exchange. JAM is not air-conditioned. Daily housekeeping service is not provided. There is no charge for children who do not need a bed (sleep in porta-crib, on the floor, etc.) and stay in a parent/guardian's room. Children under the age of 16 must room with a parent/guardian. A limited supply of portable cribs (Pack n' Plays) and fans may be rented for an additional charge.

When is check-in/check-out?

Check-in begins Thursday at noon and all classmates must check out by noon Sunday.

Can I get a room near my friends?

We can try! Just About Music (JAM) is a pod-style residence hall, with each pod containing a variety of single, double, and triple rooms. During registration, you will be asked who you'd like to room WITH and who you'd like to room NEAR. Rooming WITH is sharing a room. Rooming NEAR is staying in an adjacent room. You may request up to 6 people to room NEAR. We will do our best to accommodate your request on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that families are given priority for housing requests.

What if I need to cancel my housing registration?

A housing refund can be accommodated if you cancel on or before May 22. After this time, a refund may not be possible.

I have special medical or mobility needs, is it practical for me to stay on campus?

We want all alumni, family, and friends to enjoy campus while celebrating Reunion. Are there hotel rooms available in Ithaca during Reunion?

A limited number of rooms in several hotels have been blocked for alumni returning to Cornell. Please keep in mind that availability may be limited at this point. Review the hotel information on the Cornell Reunion website (alumni.cornell.edu/come-back/reunion/lodging/), and call your preferred hotel directly for a reservation on a first-come, first-served basis. Be sure to ask for the Reunion block.

Reunion is a family event, and there is an exciting range of activities planned for everyone, including future Cornellians! We encourage you to take advantage of the class-sponsored "Fun in the Sun" festival on Saturday and other family-friendly offerings both on and off campus! Childcare will be available through the Cornell Childcare Center for children 2-12 yrs on Saturday 6/6 from 4-9 pm. Pre-payment and registration required. 2011 will help offset that cost.
