Accommodating 114 guests, the Sea Spirit was designed to provide the ultimate in comfort and adventure in Antarctica.

Her cozy public areas provide a convivial atmosphere for socializing and relaxation. Visit the well-equipped gym or take a dip in the bubbling hot tub to warm up after exploring.

The ship design features maneuverability, which lends itself to spontaneous discoveries of polar wildlife. The vessel has an icestrengthened hull, a fleet of Zodiacs, and a set of retractable fin stabilizers for smoother sailing.
