Registration is now open for our 5th Reunion, Thursday, June 5, through Sunday, June 8!

We can't wait to celebrate our five year Reunion with you back at Cornell! While we may have graduated during the unforgettable "unprecedented" times, we will be sure to make up for lost time in celebrations over Reunion weekend. The entire university will open its doors and roll out the Big Red carpet with Slope Day 2.0(20), a wine tour to pick things up where we left off, dozens of activities, lectures, and meals that will bring you back to the glory days. Make sure to sign up by **May 15** to lock in the discounted early bird rate.

We've included a few key dates and details in this brochure that will help you make the most out of your return home to Cornell this June.

### Registration packages

The Class of 2020 is offering two packages at an early bird rate:

- **Full weekend (Thursday-Sunday): \$240**
- **Partial weekend (Friday p.m.-Sunday): \$230**

**After May 15, registration increases to \$260 for the full weekend and \$250 for the partial weekend.**

Registration includes an amazing Slope Day 2.0(20) performance you won't want to miss, continental breakfast every day, our class dinner on Saturday night, late-night (and daytime) food, unlimited beer, wine, seltzer, and non-alcoholic beverages, and numerous 2020-exclusive and university-wide events. ### Headquarters and housing

Clara Dickson Hall will be our home base for the weekend. Breakfasts, late-night gatherings, and other activities will take place in and around Dickson. Saturday's class dinner will be held under a tent on the new Ruth Bader Ginsburg Hall plaza on North Campus.

Housing is available to everyone who would like to stay on campus as the dorms are transformed into hotels for the weekend. We'll have rooms in Clara Dickson Hall and Low Rise 6. You may request housing in quieter dorms, share a room with a friend or significant other, or block rooms near friends. Please also let us know if you will need special housing accommodations for allergies, accessibility, or anything else!

We'll distribute a Google form for housing requests shortly after registration opens and will do our best to accommodate them, although we can't make guarantees. Requests must be received by the May 15 early bird deadline to be considered.

### Package FAQs

#### What does the registration fee include?

All packages include class receptions and meals, Tent Parties, class shuttles, headquarters refreshments, and most university events.

#### What is NOT automatically included?

CU for Lunch, Cornell Child Care Center services, some athletic events, and the additional opt-in selections listed here.

#### Can I celebrate with more than one class or group?

Yes! Register with the class, school, or group with whom you wish to be housed and will participate most with. Contact your class/group registration chair to share which events hosted by another class or group you'd like to add to your registration.

#### What if I register and then can't come?

We are happy to offer refunds if you cancel on or before May 23. After this date a refund of registration packages fees may not be possible.

#### Can I register when I get there?

Yes, you can—but there are many advantages to registering in advance, including lower fees (by May 15), expedited check-in, better chance of getting a room assignment near friends, and more. **Please note:** Cash payments will not be accepted. Check and credit/debit card payments are the only acceptable payment methods for Reunion purchases.

### Housing FAQs

#### What's included in the room fee?

The university provides bath towels, wash cloths, soap, hangers, bed linens, a pillow, a water glass, and a daily towel and wash cloth exchange. Daily housekeeping service is not provided. There is no charge for children who do not need a bed (sleep in porta-crib, on the floor, etc.) and stay in a parent's room.

#### When is check-in/check-out?

Check-in begins Thursday at noon and all classmates must check out by noon Sunday.

#### Can I get a room near my friends?

We can try! Rooms will be pre-assigned. If you want to room with a friend or significant other, fill out the form provided in your confirmation email (if you don't select a roommate, you will not be assigned a random roommate). If you want to make a room block to room near a group of friends, appoint one block captain to fill out the form provided in your registration confirmation email. Everyone in your group should be registered before the block captain fills out the form. We will do our best to accommodate you on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### What if I need to cancel my housing registration?

Conference and Events Services is happy to offer refunds if you cancel on or before May 23. After this time a refund may not be possible.

#### I have special medical or mobility needs—is it practical for me to stay in the residence halls?

For many guests, the answer is, yes! To communicate specific medical or mobility needs, please email us at [cornell2020council@gmail.com](mailto:cornell2020council@gmail.com) by May 23.

#### Are there hotel rooms available in Ithaca during Reunion?

A limited number of rooms in several hotels have been blocked for alumni returning to Cornell. Please keep in mind that availability may be limited at this point. Review the hotel information on the Cornell Reunion website ([alumni.cornell.edu/come-back/reunion/lodging/](http://alumni.cornell.edu/come-back/reunion/lodging/)), and call your favorite hotel directly for a reservation on a first-come, first-served basis. Be sure to ask for the Reunion block.
