Conservatory @ Bellagio

A breathtaking indoor garden with a spectacular floral display. This 50-foot-high glass roof provides a sunny place for great photo opportunities. Each season the Bellagio team transforms the 14,000 square-foot floral playground into a showcase of distinctive sights and colors of spring, summer, fall and winter-along with a special display for Chinese New Year. The setting is a wonderful, peaceful break from the bright lights of the strip and the bustle of the casino.

Fountains @ Bellagio

There is nothing like seeing them in person. The Fountains of Bellagio were destined to romance your sense. This quarter mile long manmade lake stretches between the Bellagio Hotel and Casino and the strip. Take in a spectacular show as the fountains shoot water up to 240 feet into the air. Each performance is unique in expression and interpretation so no matter how many times you have seen the fountains, they always have more in store to wow you with.

Hours of operation:

- Monday - Friday 3:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. show runs every ½ hour from 8:00 p.m. -12:00 a.m. show runs every 15 minutes.
- Saturday and Holidays 12:00 p.m. -8:00 p.m. show runs every ½ hour 8:00 p.m. - 12:00 a.m. show runs every 15 minutes
- Sunday's 11:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. show runs every 15 minutes.

The Art of Richard McDonald presented by Cirque du Soleil @ Bellagio

McDonalds gallery located outside the 'O' Theatre lobby. The gallery features more than 50 bronze sculptures along with original sketches Many of his sculptures celebrate the flexibility of dancers by presenting unique poses. McDonald also showcases a series of mime statues. Some of his pieces took him 8 years to make.

Fall of Atlantis Water Show and Aquarium @ Caesar's Palace

This show features animatronics statues acting out the story of the fall of Atlantis fountains, laser fire, steam and sound effects add to the excitement of the action.

World's Largest Permanent Circus @ Circus Circus @ the Adventuredome

One of the oldest and most loved free shows in Las Vegas since 1968, this show features aerialist, trapeze artist and clowns. The show is performed in the bigtop at the midway, which is one level up from the casino.

Hours of operation:

- Seating area opens at 11am, First act starts at 11: 15a.m and runs all day long until Midnight. On Saturday their last show is at 12:30 a.m.

Clown Show @ Circus Circus @ the Adventuredome

Check out the performance that gives clowning around a whole new meaning.

Hours of operation:

- Shows are held daily from 12:00 p.m., 1:00 p.m., 3:00 p.m. and 4 p.m. additional shows are held on Friday and Saturday at 6:00 p.m., 7 p.m. and 9 p.m.

Downtown Fremont Street Experience

A 90-foot-high four block long electronic canopy that presents spectacular sight and sound shows. This pedestrian promenade was built to attract visitors to downtown area of Las Vegas.

Hours of operation:

- Show starts every night on the hour at Dusk around (7pm) and continues until midnight or 1 a.m. depending on the day.

Fashion Shows @ Fashion Show Mall

The fashion shows take place on an 80-foot retractable runway anchored at one end by a 784-square-foot stage box within The Great Hall, a huge event venue in Fashion Show's new west wing. The runway and stage rise "almost magically" out of the shopping center floor several times daily

Hours of operation:

- Now thru Dec 31 the fashion show runs from Friday through Sunday, every hour on the hour from noon to 6:00 p.m.

Flamingo Wildlife Habitat

Past the hotel lobby and casino, you will find a collection of birds and other animals living on an island surrounded by streams and waterfalls. Over 300 birds are featured including of course, a flock of pink flamingos. You'll see penguins, swans and ducks. Living in the stream are Koi and turtles. The area also includes plants imported from around the world to make the animals feel more at home.

The Venetian Hotel and Casino Streetmosphere Shows

From opera singers and entertainers like stilt walkers, dancers and “living statues,” Streetmosphere whisks you to the heart of Italy.

Located in St. Mark’s Square (in front of the Pandora store), “Carnevale di Venezia” plays throughout the day. If you arrive a few minutes early, you can buy gelato or coffee right by the stage. You’ll also be guaranteed a good seat. The production is about 15 minutes long and includes Italian folk music and opera, you’ll have a lot of fun with the costumed performers interacting with the audience.

Seven Magic Mountains

Internationally renowned Swiss artist Ugo Rondinone’s *Seven Magic Mountains* is a large-scale site-specific public art installation located near Jean Dry Lake and Interstate 15, approximately ten miles south of Las Vegas, Nevada. Comprised of seven towers of colorful, stacked boulders standing more than thirty feet high, *Seven Magic Mountains* is situated within the Ivanpah Valley adjacent to Sheep Mountain and the McCullough, Bird Spring, and Goodsprings ranges of mountains. A creative expression of human presence in the desert, *Seven Magic Mountains* punctuates the Mojave with a poetic burst of form and color.

The Welcome to Fabulous Las Vegas sign is a Las Vegas landmark funded in May 1959 and erected soon after by Western Neon. The sign was designed by Betty Willis at the request of Ted Rogich, a local salesman, who sold it to Clark County, Nevada.
