Cayuga Lake: The middle of Cayuga Lake reaches depths over 500ft, but off the sailing center, the water is roughly 15 ft. deep.

On the water, we are provided with various sailing conditions, and the balance of conditions provides a tremendous natural arena for us.

Northerly winds are typically steady, bringing 2-3 ft. waves rolling down the lake. It's a great condition for straight-line speed and tuning. Southerly winds generate flat water & shifty conditions, something we see at many other college venues. Easterly winds are rare because of the general weather patterns. Westerly winds create dynamic sailing conditions due to the local typography featuring high hills.
